

Healing and Health

It is our heavenly Father's absolute heart and desire for His children to be healed and made completely whole. These are some of my favorite scriptures I've stood on and our family has stood on in our personal lives. Read these scriptures daily and meditate on His precious promises concerning your healing and health. Even read these healing and health scriptures 3-7 times daily and take the Word of God like medicine for your body. The Bible says that the Word of God is health or "medicine" in the Hebrew to ALL of your flesh! Enjoy beloved!

Proverbs 4:20-22 NKJV

My son, give attention to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; For they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh.

(Amplified Classic)

My son, attend to my words; consent and submit to my sayings. Let them not depart from your sight; keep them in the center of your heart. For they are life to those who find them, healing and health to all their flesh.

(The Passion Translation)

Listen carefully, my dear child to everything that I teach you, and pay attention to all that I have to say. Fill your thoughts with my words until they penetrate deep into your spirit. Then, as you unwrap my words, they will impart true life and radiant health into the very core of your being.

Hebrews 4:12 KJV

For the Word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

AMPC

For the Word that God speaks is alive and full of power [making it active, operative, energizing, and effective]; it is sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating to the dividing line of the breath of life (soul) and [the immortal] spirit, and of joints and marrow [of the deepest parts of our nature], exposing and sifting and analyzing and judging the very thoughts and purposes of the heart.

TPT

For we have the living Word of God, which is full of energy, like a two-mouthed sword. It will even penetrate to the very core of our being where soul and spirit, bone and marrow meet! It interprets and reveals the true thoughts and secret motives of our hearts.

Phillipians 2:13 KJV

For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do his good pleasure.

(Amplified Classic)

[Not in your own strength] for it is God Who is all the while effectually at work in you [energizing and creating in you the power and desire], both to will and to work for His good pleasure and satisfaction and delight.

(Mirror Bible)

Discover God himself as your inexhaustible inner source; he ignites you with both the desire and energy that matches his own delight!

Exodus 15:26 NKJV

..For I am the Lord who heals you.

(English Standard Version)

...for I am the Lord, your healer.

Romans 8:11 NKJV

But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

(New Living Translation)

The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, he will(s to) give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you.

(Amplified Classic)

And if the Spirit of Him Who raised up Jesus from the dead dwells in you, [then] He Who raised up Christ Jesus from the dead will also restore to life your mortal (short-lived, perishable) bodies through His Spirit Who dwells in you.

Romans 8:2 KJV

For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

(Amplified Classic)

For the law of the Spirit of life [which is] in Christ Jesus [the law of our new being] has freed me from the law of sin and death.

2 Corinthians 1:20 NKJV

For all the promises of God in Him are Yes and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.

(Amplified Classic)

For as many as are the promises of God, they all find their Yes [answer] in Him [Christ]. For this reason we also utter the Amen (so be it) to God through Him [in His Person and by His agency] to the glory of God.

(New Living Translation)

For all of God's promises have been fulfilled in Christ with a resounding "Yes!" And through Christ, our "Amen" (which means "Yes") ascends to God for his glory.

(Mirror Bible)

In Him the detail of every single promise of God is fulfilled; Jesus is God's yes to your total well being! In our union with him the Amen that echoes in us gives evidence to his glorious intent through us.

Romans 8:32 KJV

He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

(Message Bible)

If God didn't hesitate to put everything on the line for us, embracing our condition and exposing himself to the worst by sending his own Son, is there anything else he wouldn't gladly and freely do for us?

(New Living Translation)

Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won't he also give us everything else?

(Amplified Classic)

He who did not withhold or spare [even] His own Son but gave Him up for us all, will He not also with Him freely and graciously give us all [other] things?

(Mirror Bible)

The gift of his son is the irrefutable evidence of God's heart towards us. He held nothing in reserve; but freely and undeservedly gave everything we could ever wish to have; this is what our joint sonship is all about.

Mark 16:17-18 KJV

And these signs shall follow them that believe; in my name they shall cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

(Amplified Classic)

And these attesting signs will accompany those who believe: in My name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new languages; They will pick up serpents; and [even] if they drink anything deadly, it will not hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will get well.

Exodus 23:25-26 KJV

And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfill.

(New King James)

So you shall serve the Lord your God, and He will bless your bread and water. And I will take sickness away from the midst of you. No one shall suffer miscarriage or be barren in your land; I will fulfill the number of your days.

Duet. 7:14 KJV

Thou shalt be blessed above all people: there shall not be male or female barren among you, or among your cattle.

(Amplified Classic)

You shall be blessed above all peoples; there shall not be male or female barren among you, or among your cattle.

(New International Version)

You will be blessed more than any other people; none of your men or women will be childless, nor will any of your livestock be without young.

(New Living Translation)

You will be blessed above all the nations of the earth. None of your men or women will be childless, and all your livestock will bear young.

Deuteronomy 7:15 NKJV

And the Lord will take away from you all sickness, and will afflict you with none of the terrible diseases of Egypt which you have known, ..

Matthew 19:26 NKJV

With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.

(Amplified Classic)

With men this is impossible, but all things are possible with God.

(New Living Translation)

Humanly speaking, it is impossible. But with God everything is possible.

(Message Bible)

No chance at all if you think you can pull it off yourself. Every chance in the world if you trust God to do it.

Proverbs 17:22 KJV

A merry heart doeth good like a medicine

(English Standard Version)

A joyful heart is good medicine

(Amplified Classic)

A happy heart is good medicine and a cheerful mind works healing, but a broken spirit dries up the bones.

(The Passion Translation)

A joyful, cheerful heart brings healing to both body and soul. But the one whose heart is crushed struggles with sickness and depression.

Psalms 103:1-5 NKJV

Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless His holy Name! Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits. Who forgives all your iniquities who heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from destruction, who crowns you with loving kindness, and tender mercies, who satisfies your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

(Amplified Classic)

(Affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, O my soul; and all that is [deepest] within me, bless His holy name! Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, O my soul, and forget not [one of] all His benefits- Who forgives [every one of] all your iniquities, Who heals [each one of] all your diseases, Who redeems your life from the pit and corruption, Who beautifies, dignifies, and crowns you with loving-kindness and tender mercy; Who satisfies your mouth [your necessity and desire at your personal age and situation] with good so that your youth, renewed, is like the eagle's [strong, overcoming, soaring]!

Psalms 107:20 NKJV

He sent His Word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

(Contemporary English Version)

By the power of his own word, he healed you and saved you from destruction.

(English Standard Version)

He sent out his word and healed them, and delivered them from their destruction.

Jeremiah 30:17 NKJV

'For I will restore health to you and heal you of your wounds', says the LORD.

(New Living Translation)

"I will give you back your health and heal your wounds," says the LORD.

Isaiah 58:8 KJV

Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy rearward.

(Geneva Bible)

Then shall thy light breake foorth as the morning, and thine health shall grow speedily: thy righteousness shall goe before thee, and the glorie of the Lord shall embrace thee.

(New Living Translation)

Then your salvation will come like the dawn, and your wounds will quickly heal. Your godliness will lead you forward, and the glory of the LORD will protect you from behind.

Psalms 91:16 NKJV

With long life I will satisfy him, and show him My salvation.

Isaiah 53:4-5 NKJV

Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.

(Amplified Classic)

Surely He has borne our griefs (sicknesses, weaknesses, and distresses) and carried our sorrows and pains [of punishment], yet we [ignorantly] considered Him stricken, smitten, and afflicted by God [as if with leprosy]. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our guilt and iniquities; the chastisement [needful to obtain] peace and well-being for us was upon Him, and with the stripes [that wounded] Him we are healed and made whole.

(Message Bible)

But the fact is, it was our pains he carried-our disfigurements, all the things wrong with us. We thought he brought it on himself, that God was punishing him for his own failures. But it was our sins that did that to him, that ripped and tore and crushed him-our sins! He took the punishment, and that made us whole. Through his bruises we get healed.

1 Peter 2:24 NKJV

Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness-by whose stripes you were healed.

(Amplified Classic)

He personally bore our sins in His [own] body on the tree [as on an altar and offered Himself on it], that we might die (cease to exist) to sin and live to righteousness. By His wounds you have been healed.

(The Passion Translation)

He himself carried our sins in his body on the cross so that we would be dead to sin and live for righteousness. Our instant healing flowed from his wounding.

Matthew 8:17 NKJV

He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses.

(Amplified Classic)

And thus He fulfilled what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah, He Himself took [in order to carry away] our weaknesses and infirmities and bore away our diseases.

(The Passion Translation)

He put upon himself our weaknesses, and he carried away our diseases and made us well.

(New Living Translation)

He took our sicknesses and removed our diseases.

(Free Bible Version)

He healed our diseases, and freed us from our illnesses.

Matthew 8:2,3 KJV

And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

(New International Version)

A man with leprosy came and knelt before him and said, "Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean." Jesus reached out his hand and touched the man. "I am willing," he said. "Be clean!" Immediately he was cleansed of his leprosy.

(New Living Translation)

Suddenly, a man with leprosy approached him and knelt before him. "Lord," the man said, "if you are willing, you can heal me and make me clean." Jesus reached out and touched him. "I am willing," he said. "Be healed!" And instantly the leprosy disappeared.

(The Passion Translation)

Suddenly, a leper walked up to Jesus and threw himself down before him in worship and said, "Lord, you have the power to heal me... if you really want to." Jesus reached out his hand and touched the leper and said, "Of course I want to heal you-be healed!" And instantly, all signs of leprosy disappeared!

Mark 16:17, 18 KJV

And these signs shall follow those who believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

(Amplified Classic)

And these attesting signs will accompany those who believe: in My name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new languages; They will pick up serpents; and [even] if they drink anything deadly, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will get well.

Galations 3:13, 14 NKJV

Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

(Amplified Classic)

Christ purchased our freedom [redeeming us] from the curse (doom) of the Law [and its condemnation] by [Himself] becoming a curse for us, for it is written [in the Scriptures], Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree (is crucified); To the end that through [their receiving] Christ Jesus, the blessing [promised] to Abraham might come upon the Gentiles, so that we through faith might [all] receive [the realization of] the promise of the [Holy] Spirit.

(The Passion Translation)

Yes, Christ paid the full price to set us free from the curse of the law. He absorbed it completely as he became a curse in our place. For it is written: "Everyone who is hung upon a tree is doubly cursed." Jesus, our Messiah, was cursed in our place and in so doing, dissolved the curse from our lives, so that all the blessings of Abraham can be poured out upon even non-Jewish believers. And now God gives us the promise of the wonderful Holy Spirit who lives within us when we believe in him.

3 John 2 KJV

Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

(Amplified Classic)

Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in every way and [that your body] may keep well, even as [I know] your soul keeps well and prospers.

Nahum 1:9 NKJV

Affliction will not rise up a second time.
